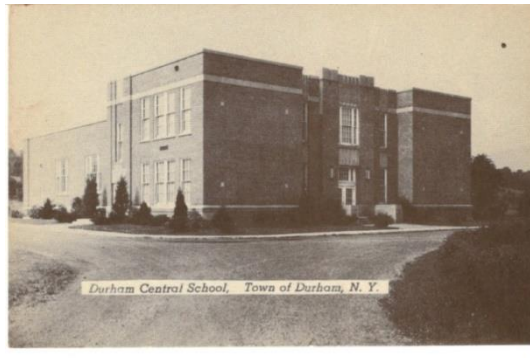


June Thursdays at the Durham Community Center
