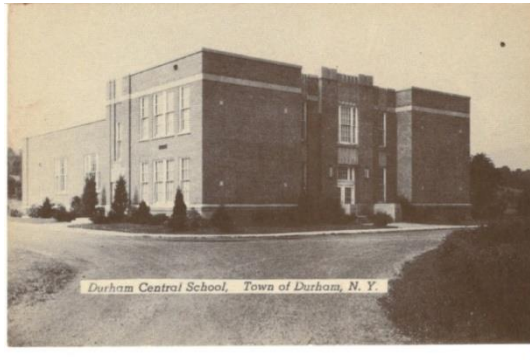


August Thursdays at the Durham Community Center
