

A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Durham, County of Greene and the State of New York was held at the Town Hall, 7309 State Route 81, East Durham, NY on the 3rd day of September.

OTHERS PRESENT: Joe van Holsteyn-Deputy Highway Superintendent, Thomas Sutton-Police Sgt., and 8 community members.

Supervisor Carr called the meeting to order 7:30 p.m. with compliments to the fire departments for the outstanding job they did containing a structure fire at the former Sharkey's apartment. Supervisor Carr thanked all the responders, fire departments, auxiliary, ambulance and police.

Supervisor reported the traffic study conducted on County Route 20 conducted over a five day period tagged approximately 250 vehicles. The highest speed tagged was 52 miles per hour on the 45 per hour marked road with the majority traveling at or below the speed limit. The police department will continue to monitor the speed for this road. The motorcyclist that had been reported as being a nuisance has been incarcerated and should no longer be an issue.

Ken Leogrande presented the board with a receipt from Smiley's to prove the unregistered vehicle he was cited for has been removed from his property. Mr. Leogrande also requested that future correspondence be mailed to the address provided to the Supervisor.

Having reviewed the quotes obtained in accordance with the Town of Durham procurement policy, Mr. Cunningham motioned to approve the purchase of a 10' 5.6 yard stainless Hydraulic Spreader from Robert Green Truck and to purchase a 9' one-way, reversible snow plow from Loughberry Mfg. via a piggyback contract with the Town of Thompson Highway Division, Montecello, NY both seconded by Mr. Nahas all in favor motion carried. (Yea-Carr, Sutton, Cunningham, Nahas, Wood)

Having reviewed the quotes obtained in accordance with the Town of Durham procurement policy Mr. Nahas motioned to approve to purchase new propane boiler installation kit for \$2,271.88 as quoted by N&S Supply seconded by Mrs. Sutton all in favor motion carried. (Yea-Carr, Sutton, Cunningham, Nahas, Wood)

Supervisor Carr stated the NYS Department of Transportation will once again review the passing zone and speed near the Knights of Columbus Hall and the Milk Run Convenience Store and following their survey will make the determination to make changes or not.

Supervisor Carr reminded the board of the upcoming Emergency Management Meeting; Ms. Wood stated she was very interested, however, would not be able to attend and urged the other board members to attend it at all possible.

Mrs. Sutton announced that residents in the hamlet of East Durham have received correspondence from NYS Department of Transportation stating that Route 145 will be closed starting September 30 to allow for the replacement of a culvert pipe.

Ms. Wood asked if the town could speak with Mr. Dudley on behalf of the fire department and residents pertaining to the dry hydrant located on the former Becker Durham Property which he now owns. Discussion followed. Ms. Wood will contact Attorney Rappleyea and ask him to draft a written agreement allowing the town to have access to the dry hydrant.

Mrs. Rascoe invited everyone to attend the next DurhamNY Chamber meeting Tuesday September 10, 7 p.m. at the Durham Town Hall.

Councilmember Nahas invited all to attend a seminar Saturday September 14 at 7 p.m.; hosted by Oak Hill Preservation Association on "Documenting Our History".

Ms. Wood motioned to adjourn at 7:49 p.m. seconded by Mrs. Sutton meeting adjourned.
