

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Durham, County of Greene and the State of New York was held at the Town Hall, 7309 State Route 81, East Durham, NY on the 2nd, day of September.

OTHERS PRESENT: Joe van Holsteyn-Highway Superintendent, David Cunningham-Building Inspector, Thomas Sutton-Police Sgt., John Van Tassel-Animal Control Officer and 12 community members.

Supervisor Carr called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Ledda Subdivision: The board reviewed the road maintenance agreement and tabled making a motion to approve until Attorney Rapplelea arrives.

The board received a request to reapprove a subdivision for a property on Stonebridge Road which was originally approved April 1, 1999 and never filed with the county. Due to the lapse of time since the original application was approved the board determined that the applicant needed to resubmit the application for review under the current subdivision guidelines.

Blackthorne Resort Mass Gathering Application: Supervisor Carr asked the board to review the application received September 2, 2014 for an event on September 11,12,13 & 14 and to immediately bring any issues to his attention so they can be addressed and rectified expeditiously due to the time sensitivity.

Highway Superintendent van Holsteyn informed the board he will be able to oil and stone Carter Bridge Road and School House Road with CHIP money. He has received 270 tons of the 300 tons of salt he reserved. He is expecting a 27% price increase in salt.

Mrs. Sutton stated the East Durham Sidewalk dedication will be October 3rd at 2 p.m. across the street from the East Durham Fire House.

The Republican Club will hold their annual Elsie Allan Dinner September 7 from 4 a.m. to 7 p.m. at the Blackthorne Resort.

Motorists are urged not to park their cars on the sidewalks and are notified that the police will be issuing warnings followed by tickets to those who choose not to obey the law.

Mr. Cunningham motioned to approve the Mass Gathering Application from Blackthorne Resort with the condition that the Town Attorney review and any concerns are addressed prior to the issuance of the permit and opening of the event. Motion seconded by Mr. Nahas all in favor motion carried. (5-yeas Carr, Sutton, Cunningham, Nahas, Deckers)

Mrs. Sutton motioned to approve the Ledda subdivision with the condition that the Town Attorney review and concerns are addressed prior to the stamping of the surveys. (5-yeas Carr, Sutton, Cunningham, Nahas, Deckers)

Supervisor Carr read a letter received from Greene County Emergency Services requesting a letter of support for a grant application seeking funding to enhance the current program. He will contact the agency head to get additional information prior to drafting a response.

Mrs. Sutton motioned to adjourn at 7:53 p.m. seconded by Mr. Nahas.
