Apply Now for Housing Recovery Assistance

Apply Now for Funding Assistance if Storms Sandy, Irene or Lee Damaged Your Residence

If your residential property was damaged by Superstorm Sandy, Hurricane Irene or Tropical Storm Lee, you may be eligible for financial assistance, including home repair/rehabilitation, mitigation/elevation and/or buyouts.

The Recreate NY Smart Home Program is now accepting registrations for housing assistance from residents located in disaster-declared counties. These registrations will be used to determine program eligibility for each registrant. This includes counties affected by Hurricane Irene or Tropical Storm Lee.

Property owners are urged to apply now, as funds will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Owners of single-family residences, condominiums, co-ops, and rental properties may be eligible. The funds will not cover the same expenses as those covered under disaster-related assistance you have already received, or may be eligible for from other federal, state, local and/or private sources of disaster-related assistance, including, but not limited to, homeowners and/or flood insurance proceeds.
