The Town of Durham is considering a Community Center/Reading Room in East Durham.

The proposed facility would occupy between 3,000 and 5,000 square feet in a rented or leased property on Route 145.

Preliminary plans call for a facility with high speed internet access and terminals for use by students and other residents.

The facility will also include a meeting area with audio visual equipment, rest rooms and a kitchenette to support use by civic groups.

The current Durham Reading Room staff will move to the new facility which will insure 20 hours per week of facility availability with additional hours as needs and resources permit.

We need Community input to determine the level of Community interest and support for the facility.
