A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Durham, County of Greene and the State of New York was held at the Town Hall, 7309 State Route 81, East Durham, NY on the 7th, day of January.

Supervisor Carr called the meeting to order 7:35 p.m.

Bids were opened for the police car. Sgt. Sutton having reviewed the single bid received, and having ensured it was a qualified bid **Ms. Wood motioned to award the bid to Mark Gottenberg for a 2011 Ford Crown Victoria, to be painted white and delivered in February 2014, seconded by Mr. Nahas all in favor motion carried.** (5-yea, Carr, Wood, Cunningham, Sutton, Nahas)

As Code Enforcement Officer Asaro was absent due to illness discussion regarding Shapanack Resort was tabled.

Supervisor Carr explained the need to reach a decision regarding the maintenance of sidewalks in the hamlet of East Durham. Who will be responsible and what are the expectations? He will seek input from the community and highway department on this topic.

Ms. Wood commented that Central Hudson has a program where they install poles and lights and the town would rent them. Ms. Wood will seek further information.

Mr. Cunningham motioned to increase the gravesite fee for Winston Cemetery from \$250 to \$750.00 seconded by Mrs. Wood

all in favor motion carried. (5-yea, Carr, Wood, Cunningham, Sutton, Nahas)

Mrs. Sutton is organizing a meeting with various community groups and citizens to discuss additional improvements to the East Durham Sidewalk project.

Ms. Wood motioned to adjourn at 7:52 p.m. seconded by Mr. Nahas.
